# How to run this downloadable Murder Mystery Game

## Instructions for 'Operation Murder' – 14 Players

Please note that this game has 14 characters. The male roles are Mal, Aachen, Ray, Willie, Lance, Ammin and Parry.

### 1) Instructions For Printing After You Have Purchased And Downloaded

- You will need Paper (A4 or similar), scissors and 14 envelopes (minimum size 22cm by 13cm)
- You should have ready for printing:

- A/** These 'How To Run' instructions  
Introduction  
Police bulletin
- B/** Player invitations  
Ideas for costumes
- C/** Player slips
- D/** Player clues
- E/** Accusation list  
Solution to the Mystery
- F/** Labels
- G/** Banner

### 2) Printing

Print out the following:

- A/ One copy**
  - How to run
  - Introduction /group clue
- B/ Fourteen copies**
  - invitations
  - Costume suggestions
- C/ One copy**
  - player slips
  - cut along the dotted lines and place each players slips in an envelope on which you should write their name (do this task with the papers upside down and try not to read anything!)
- D/** Print out the player clues (one copy of each). Fold each clue up from the bottom leaving only the top two lines showing
- E/** Print out one copy of the accusation list and solution taking care to fold the solution with-  
out reading it
- F/** Print one copy of the labels
- G/** Print one copy of the banner if required

### 3) In advance of playing the game

- Allocate the characters to the players using the information on the invitation and ideas for costumes.
- Send an invitation and ideas for costumes sheet to each player at least one week before the Murder Mystery takes place (to give them chance to organise their costumes)
- You may wish to prepare labels or nametags for each character on the night (if you do, please be careful with delicate fabrics)

#### 4) On The Night

- Welcome your guests with a nametag or label
- Hand out the player envelopes and clues
- Read out the introduction and then the police bulletin
- Each player reads their 'Secret information' slip to themselves
- Commence the game with each player reading out his or her 'Round 1-Reveal this information now' slips (starting with the hosts)
- Work through the remaining rounds ensuring that each player has read their slip (and clue if appropriate) before moving on to the next round
- This game has seven rounds. After the final round the players should make their accusations giving their reasons. Use the list to decide the order of the accusations
- When all accusations have been made the host reads out the solution to the mystery.

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## **INTRODUCTION**

### **NARRATIVE TO BE READ OUT AT THE START OF ROUND 1**

**(Voice 1)**

“Good evening ladies and gentlemen and welcome to the formal opening of the brand new Snife Wing here at Killlem Hall Hospital. This new wing has been made possible through the efforts of our chief executive, Sir John Snife. Since he was promoted from head surgeon to Chief Executive he has embarked on a single minded campaign of cost cutting and a ruthless efficiency drive which have drastically reduced our operating costs. With the further savings he has promised from his attack on irregularities and corruption the wing will be fully self financing. Sir John has just had to pop out for his insulin injection and will be joining us shortly.

Ladies and gentlemen please welcome our Chief Executive and the man responsible for the new wing, Sir John Snife (Polite applause)

**(Voice 2)**

“Good evening ladies and gentlemen. It has taken a lot of hard work and unpopular decisions to get us where we are today and I am very proud that the board of directors decided to name the new wing after me. Without any further ado I should like to cut the ribbon and declare the Snife Wing oooooaarrgh.

(Gasps)

**(Voice 1)**

“Oh no, he’s collapsed. Is there a doctor in the building?”

**(Voice 3)**

“I am afraid it is too late for that, he’s dead.”

## **GROUP CLUE TO BE READ OUT AND CIRCULATED AFTER THE INTRODUCTION**

“Good evening ladies and gentlemen, my name is P.C. Monitor. We have now completed our initial forensic tests into the tragic death of Sir John Snife and I have some shocking news.

Sir John, who I am sure you all knew was a diabetic, had just popped out for his insulin injection. Unfortunately the insulin injection that he had given himself did not contain his usual dose of insulin. Instead it contained a concentrated dose of Sodium Thiopentone which had been put into an insulin phial.

We have checked thoroughly and have come to the conclusion that there is no way that the Sodium Thiopentone, which is a drug used in small doses as an anaesthetic, could have got into the insulin phial by accident. This means that it was placed there deliberately and Sir John’s death was murder.

We shall now be continuing our investigations and I must request that nobody leaves until our enquiries are complete.

**Aachen Head.** Wears a white doctor's coat, white shirt and a black tie. Carries a stethoscope and has a hip flask in his pocket.

**Ray D. O'Grapher.** Wears a white coat, sunglasses and carries an x-ray envelope. He has some lottery scratch cards in his pocket which he tries to sell to the others.

**Drew Blood.** Wears a pale blue or white nurse's outfit with a white nurse's hat. Wears a watch, a wide red belt, black stockings and black shoes.

**Willie Everwake.** Wears a green gown and has a green mask hanging around his neck. Wears theatre clogs or plastic shoes

**Sister Sledge.** Wears a dark blue or white nurse's uniform with a blue nurse's hat, pocket watch and black shoes. Carries a clipboard and a set of staffing schedules

**Lance Boyles.** Wears a white or cream suit with a colourful bowtie. Carries a copy of What Car Magazine and has a large cigar.

**Cilla Con.** Wears a green gown, gloves and clogs or plastic shoes. Carries a selection chart for nose jobs and breast enlargement operations


**Ammin Trubbel.** Wears a white coat and carries a black bag. Has a stethoscope round his neck and carries a small cool bag full of icepacks.

## ROUND 1 SECRET INFORMATION

You had to falsify prescriptions to get the books to balance and you were worried that Sir John was on to your little scam. You had not yet done anything about your concerns. You were not even at the pharmacy when Sir John's last prescription was prepared as you were on holiday and being covered by locums.

## ROUND 2 TELL THE GROUP

DEE SPENCE

I have just returned from a two week holiday in Ibiza. I had a great time in all of the clubs all night and in bed all day, occasionally on my own. I love going on 18 to 30 singles holidays because they are a great way to get some serious party action.

ROUND 3 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY MAL PRACTICE

DEE SPENCE

The hospital pharmacy had a supply of Viagra that was not being used so I was just preventing it from being wasted. I had to order some more to keep my regulars stocked up. I did think it was a bit dangerous sending some to Sir John but I always sent it from a PO Box address. I did wonder if he was on to me but there is no way that I am a killer.



ROUND 4 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY AMMIN TRUBBEL

DEE SPENCE

There are only two sets. I have the master set and Sir John himself had the other set.

ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY SISTER SLEDGE

It would be quite fiddly and would take about five minutes. However anybody with a basic understanding of hypodermic needles would be able to have done it.



ROUND 5 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY RAY D O'GRAPHER

I always put together John's prescription which he let me have every fortnight. There is no way that I could have got Insulin mixed up with Sodium Thiopentone as they are in different sections of the Pharmacy and the Sodium Thiopentone is locked in a cupboard with the other anaesthetics.

ROUND 1 REVEAL THIS INFORMATION NOW

MAL PRACTICE

My name is Mal Practice and I am the senior surgeon here at Killlem Hall Hospital. I have been the senior surgeon since Sir John was promoted to the position of Chief Executive and I do the more complicated operations such as heart transplants.



ROUND 1 SECRET INFORMATION

MAL PRACTICE

You have recently been making a lot of mistakes during operations and then trying to cover up the consequences by blaming anybody else in the theatre team. Sir John had been investigating all of the claims against the Hospital and was planning to suspend you. You had thought about trying to stop Sir John's enquiries but had not thought of a way of stopping him. *You are not the murderer.*



ROUND 2 ASK WILLIE EVERWAKE

MAL PRACTICE

I assume that you had access to Sodium Thiopentone as one of the theatre anaesthetics. Did you fall out with the old man and kill him?

**ROUND 3 ASK DEE SPENCE**

MAL PRACTICE

Sir John was a big friend of yours. Who do you think will get all of his dosh, because he hadn't got any family to leave it to?


## ROUND 6 TELL THE GROUP



Don't you think that you bring the profession of nursing into disrepute with your promiscuous behaviour and all of these one night stands with your work colleagues?




### ROUND 5 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY CILLA CON

ANN T SEPTIC



**ROUND 5 ASK WILLIE EVERWAKE**

**ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY RAY D O'GRAPHER**

Yes we've got a big 'Doctors and Nurses' party lined up for next Saturday. We are doing some posters that say 'Grab your crutch and come' It should be a great night.

You saved a letter on the computer the other day and you left your private disk in the disk drive. I had to check it out to find out whose it was and the letter shows that you had good grounds to kill Sir John.

### ROUND 4 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY WILLIE EVERWAKE

RAY D O'GRAPHER

I did have a great idea to adapt our Scanner to pick out lottery scratch cards winners but I did not know for definite that Sir John was on to me. If I didn't know that he was on to my secret why would I kill him? Anyway I wasn't hurting anybody with what I was doing.

How did you first get into dealing in Viagra?


### ASK AACHEN HEAD

RAY D O'GRAPHER



DREW BLOOD


ROUND 7 ASK DEE SPENCE

DREW BLOOD

ASK AACHEN HEAD

I heard that they are planning to introduce random breath tests for all doctors and surgeons. Will you be leaving before they do?



ROUND 1 REVEAL THIS INFORMATION NOW

WILLIE EVERWAKE

My name is Willie Everwake and I am the senior anaesthetist here at Killem Hall Hospital. I have held that position for 10 years and, for much of that time, I worked alongside Sir John on his operations. I counted John as one of my closest friends and I will greatly miss him.



ROUND 1 SECRET INFORMATION

WILLIE EVERWAKE

You invented a new aphrodisiac spray for men who wished to get a girl a bit frisky. It was a mixture of Nitrous Oxide (from the hospitals anaesthetic supplies) and an experimental pheromone you had come up with in the lab. Internet sales were going well but Sir John, who you thought was your friend, was following up a police enquiry into a spray used in some date rape cases and was checking out the hospital lab records and supplies. You had considered an accident for him but had not thought of a foolproof way. Then somebody did the job for you. *You are not the killer.*



ROUND 2 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY MAL PRACTICE

WILLIE EVERWAKE

I did have a small stock in my locked cupboard but I only kept an emergency supply and got it in fresh from the pharmacy whenever I needed it for an operation. I certainly didn't have access to the case in which he kept his personal insulin kit. Anyway why should I kill him when we go back such a long way?

ROUND 3 ASK CILLA CON

### ROUND 5 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY EMMA ROIDS



Didn't I see you behind the counter in the Pharmacy when I walked past yesterday?




ROUND 5 ANSWER WHEN ASKED BY DREW BLOOD

AMMIN TRUBBEL



EMMA ROIDS




### **14/Sister Sledge**
